Trick 1) a diamond is led and dummy plays the Ace.  
*The Ace diamonds is ruffed !*

Trick 2) The Ace spades is led and declarer ruffs with the Ace clubs.  
*The defender on declarer's left discards a heart*

Tricks 3) The 5 clubs is led to dummy's Jack  
*The defender on declarer's right discards a spade*
