10)3NT. Ha ! Im right aren't I ? Yes and the reason you didn't bid 4Sp ?

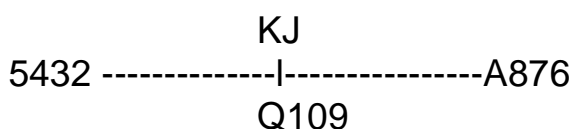
Alimentary (canal) my dear Dr Watson –partner may have bid 2 Spades with only three spades not four.

11) Double –a penalty double OR 2NT

11)We will keep the spade finesse in reserve. For now the correct play is to try to establish a diamond by force. Ie we will play a round of diamonds , then another round , when we have the lead again , yet another round.

Our 8 diamonds will become good

You are hoping the diamonds are distributed something like this :-



b) hmm slightly harder but basically the same establishment by force play as in (a).

Win heart-go to Ace clubs *in order to play weak to strong* in diamonds.

Lead a small diamond to the K. Open your eyes and see if it has won. If it has keep leading diamonds until another trick falls into your lap.
