

## Answers review

1) 2D and NOT 2H. ok ? 2H would be a reverse showing 15+

2) too early to give in –bid Double . A reopening dble. Partner will speak.

3) nothing to say ( but what a day how's your boy been..) [ Beatles ]

we don't much like 1S but there is nothing to say -1NT would be wrong ( and shows about 10-12 opposite an overcall –didn't know that did u ?) –bidding 2H is unnecessary. Pass is the call.

4) 2H. Clear cut. Partner will probably pass.

5) 1H –middle of three

6) Ace clubs ; 2 hearts DANGEROUS defence ie Strong distributional dummy

7) Win Q diamonds ; play Ace diamonds; play a spade PASSIVE defence ie balanced dummy

8) Win at trick 1; lead a club to the Ace and then another club; next time I have the lead , lead another club. Establishment by force. Play your “long” suit and keep playing it

9) Win at trick 1 with J Hrts ; lead a club to the King [ and hope that wins ] ... then another club; next time I have the lead , lead another club. Establishment by force. Play your “long” suit and keep playing. Quite similar to the one above begad.

“But but ..it never happens like that when I play , the K clubs loses , and ....”.
