- 1) 2Sp lots of tricks (5 sp + AK h + A d)
- 2) 1H NOT 2H please
you have the pnts but not the tricks
- 3) 2NT (or 1Sp for really old fashioned players)
- 4) 2NT or 1Sp
- 5) 4Sp 8 cards but a weak(ish) hand -just a preempt
- 6) 1H
- 7) 2Sp (8 playing tricks again)
- 7!) 4H ? perhaps but you do have an outside Ace which you aren't sposed to have for a preempt. Was a freely dealt hand from last week and H.S. opened 4H. I think 4H fine.
- 8) 2NT neg no A+K
- 9) 2NT neg NB not allowed to pass
- 10) 2NT neg AND yes , you will probably go 4Sp in due course but first show the neg
- 11) 2NT
- 12) 3H (an A + K) and some hrts
- 13) 4sp is about right
